Q1: Please tell me about preferential treatments for JpGU-AGU joint sessions.

A1: [1] Two time slots are allotted for a new session.

Two or more slots are allotted for the session which was held in past meetings based on the numbers of abstracts submitted at that time.

[2] No restriction on the number of invited lectures

[3] Joint session promotion expenses are planned to be given.

[4] Advertisements both at JpGU and AGU websites

Q2: Can I (JpGU convener) double as AGU convener?

A2: Convener from AGU can be a Japanese, but at least one JpGU convener and one AGU convener are necessary.

Q3: Please advise how to hold a JpGU-AGU Joint session.

A3: Firstly, please make a session proposal from JpGU website. Please be sure to write the comments that it is a JpGU-AGU Joint session.

Please contact respective section or focus group that your session is planned to be a JpGU-AGU joint.

Q4: Do I have to hold the continuous session at AGU Fall Meeting 2016?

A4: It is not required.

Q5: Can I hold this session as a JpGU-AGU joint if I apply to?

A5: Both JpGU and AGU program committee chairs adopt joint sessions. If it's not adopted as a JpGU-AGU joint, it's held as normal English session.

Q6: Is the same system applied to JpGU-AGU Joint Meeting 2017?

A6: JpGU-AGU Meeting 2017 is a whole joint meeting.

Program committee for JpGU-AGU Meeting 2017 consists of both JpGU and AGU program committee members.

Every session is considered as a joint session.

Q7: Can I change the session already proposed to the JpGU-AGU joint?

A7: Yes, you can freely change it to the JpGU-AGU joint by the session proposal deadline.
